But as DMF sales and marketing manager Maureen Lawexplains, "This still left us without any data processing too assist manufacturing.

"We had an absolute need to do something. For example, to answer such questions as 'how much material does production need."

"As such we looked at a very wide range of IT packages. Some couldn't do all that we wanted them to do. And all out were of the question from a budgetary viewpoint. And thus our solution was to take MYOB data and then crunch the needed numbers manually. A rather tedious and time consuming process that was clearly not ideal."



"It is also fair to say that this way of doing things meant we were always being reactive as opposed to being proactive. We saw ourselves as still being rather too far behind the eight ball. Remembering that while customers typically require immediate delivery, there is a three months order lead time for brass, one of our major raw materials. So if you are not on the top of inventory levels you can have serious issues arise."

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Partnering with Epitome and Ostendo

Says Ms Lawlor, "Some short time later we were then introduced to Ostendo. A computer solution that had just been released in South Australia and which was being supplied and supported by Epitome."

"From a cost perspective, this looked very attractive. So it was then good to find out it could give us exactly what we needed. The decision to adopt Ostendo was thus a pretty straightforward one."
